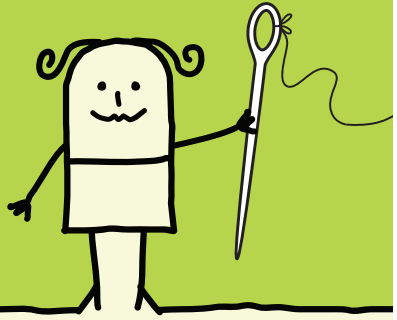


Sew Energy Efficient
