This programme will invite 260 participants and we will let you know how you can get involved in future features.





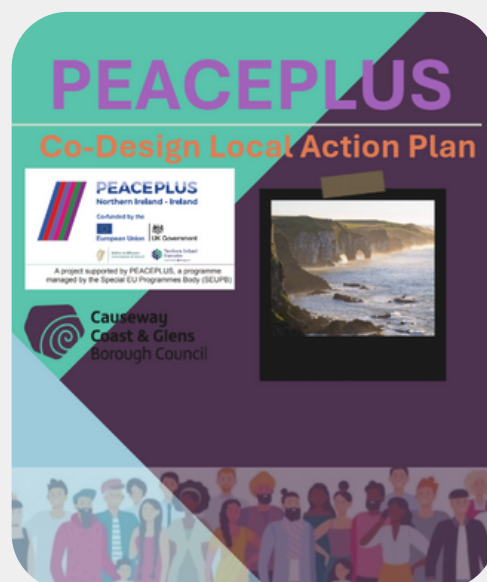
## THE PEACEPLUS Delivery Agents

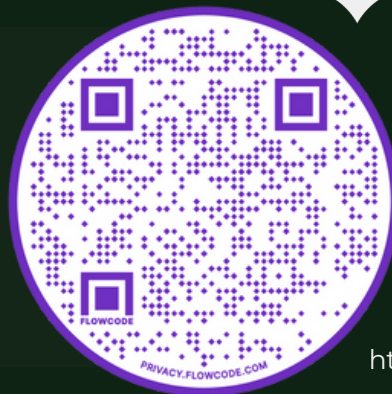
