

Information

The 153rd Open will be played at Royal Portrush from 13 - 20 July 2025. This will mark the third time the Championship has been staged in Portrush with fans from across the world arriving to watch the very best men's golfers compete for the iconic Claret Jug. The Open delivers an annual economic benefit of over £150m to its host region, while the Championship's commercial success supports the development of golf worldwide.

This information board has been provided by The R&A, organisers of The Open, together with Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council to provide useful information to those who regularly access Portrush. A Guide for Local Residents will also be circulated to all homes and businesses in the area and further copies made available for collection from Portrush Town Hall, 1 Mark Street, Portrush, BT56 8DX.

Build and Derig Period: March to August

Extensive planning is carried out in preparation for The Open to ensure minimum disruption during the week of the Championship and in the construction and derig phases. The R&A and Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council are committed to working with residents and local businesses to facilitate access and movement around the town to allow people to go about their daily lives with as little disruption as possible. To further support this, The R&A has set up an off-site reporting office so that all deliveries can be managed to keep heavy vehicle movements on local roads to a minimum. Following feedback received about arrangements in place in 2019, all equipment and infrastructure brought into, and removed from, the venue will be delivered by a designated route keeping it away from the town centre and avoiding passing any schools or built up areas where possible. This will minimise any disruption to residents and local businesses and keep the roads around Portrush moving freely.

Championship Week: Sunday 13 July – Sunday 20 July inclusive

In the interests of public safety and security, which are paramount at a major sporting event, temporary traffic regulation orders will be in place to help manage traffic flow during the Championship. Further details of local restrictions and closures will be published on the Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council website in due course. There will also be further details available at the weekly information drop-in sessions starting in May held at Portrush Town Hall. White Rocks Car Park	Saturday 12 July to Monday 21 July

*Blue Badge Spaces will be retained for use by public Blue Badge Holders (subject to availability).
