	The DCS also mentioned that as International Women's Day is an opportunity to not only remember the struggles and resistance that women across the world have endured but also to recognise the many achievements that have been won, this will be an excellent opportunity to have an exhibition of notable women from the Borough.	
	She went on to explained that the Council's collection is currently being checked for suitable exhibits and it is proposed to extract the Women from the 'Famous Sons and Daughters' exhibition and have this displayed in the Roe Valley Arts and Cultural Centre.	
	It was pointed out that Council has not set aside any budget for this event but that the Museums section is in possession of the above-mentioned exhibition and it is anticipated that the Mayor will meet the costs of the Reception.	DCS
	At this point, the DCS referred to the Draft Action Plan and advised that this would be included on the Agenda for the next Meeting in order for work to recommence.
