- 2.1 The Armed Forces Covenant is a voluntary statement of mutual support between a civilian community and its local Armed Forces Community which Council signed in January 2017. This Covenant encompasses the moral obligation between the Nation, the Government and the Armed Forces at a local level.
- 2.2 The annual Armed Forces Covenant Conference is an opportunity for everyone interested in delivery of the Armed Forces Covenant to get together to network, to share best practice, and to learn about the latest Covenant developments.
- 2.3 It is organised by the Ministry of Defence, and attended by representatives from central, devolved and local government, the leading Armed Forces charities, the NHS and education sectors, academics, and more. There will be a range of keynote speakers and breakout sessions, information stands from third sector organisations including networking opportunities.
