1.0 Purpose of Report

The purpose of the report is to seek approval for the Leisure & Development Terms of Reference (ToR) following the recommended annual review.

2.0 Background

At a Special Council Meeting held on 27th March 2023 Council resolved to accept the recommendations contained within the '*independent review of governance arrangements in Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council report*'.

At a Special Council Meeting held on 30th October 2023 Council resolved to implement the recommendations arising from the reviews to address the recommendations from the Extraordinary Audit and to set these out as a comprehensive Transformation Programme.

Recommendation G11 states that "a periodic review of Committees should be included in the Terms of Reference and put into practice to help Committees understand what aspects work well and what could be improved."

The Leisure and Development Committee approved this recommendation at its meeting on 19 March 2024, and subsequently the ToR is to be reviewed on an annual basis.

3.0 Updated Terms of Reference

Following the recommended annual review, the updated Terms of Reference can be found at **Annex A**.

4.0 Recommendation

It is recommended that approval is granted for the updated Leisure and Development Committee Terms of Reference following the recommended review. (**Annex A**)



LEISURE AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.0 Scope

The Leisure and Development Committee ("the Committee") will be responsible for recommending to Council the key decisions and actions required to be taken specifically in relation to the work of the Leisure and Development (L&D) Directorate.

This will include:

- The oversight of the following service areas, (financial performance will primarily be provided via the Finance Committee):
 - o Community and Culture.
 - o Prosperity and Place (including updates from Growth Deal, LMP, Coleraine Future Towns and the LEP)
 - o Tourism and Recreation.
 - o Sport and Wellbeing.
 - o The Funding Unit (including PEACEPLUS updates)
- Overseeing the delivery of the aforementioned services and strategies for the L&D Directorate and making appropriate recommendations to Council;
- Recommending to Council relevant policies and procedures for the L&D Directorate;
- The future development of the organisational structure for the L&D Directorate;
- Developing, Monitoring and Reviewing annual business and service delivery plans for the L&D Directorate;
- Recommending to Council the establishment of external partnerships where considered relevant to the role of the L&D Directorate;
- The development and delivery of Capital Projects that exist within the scope of the L&D Directorate;
- Making recommendations to Council and monitoring funding sources and mechanisms to assist with various initiatives, projects and actions within the remit of the L&D Directorate;
- Recommending to Council the resolution of any associated issues;
- Considering the resource implications of any recommendations.

2.0 Membership

The Committee is comprised of sixteen Elected Members and they were appointed to the Committee at the Annual General Meeting of Council on 01 June 2026. Members may be required to represent the Committee and Council at pertinent consultation and capacity building events. The membership list for the Committee is provided at **Appendix A**.

3.0 Chair

The Committee will be chaired in 2026/27 by Councillor Peter McCully (ALL). In the absence of the Chairperson, the Committee will be chaired by the Deputy Chairperson, Councillor Ashleen Schenning (SDLP). In the absence of the Deputy Chairperson, a chair for the meeting will be agreed by the Members present.

4.0 Meetings

The first meeting of the Committee after the 2026 Annual General Meeting was held on Tuesday 16th June 2026. The L&D Committee will normally meet on the third Tuesday of each month at 7.00 pm except when this falls within a recess period agreed by Council. A schedule of meetings for the Committee for the 2026/27 year is attached as **Appendix B**. All meetings of the Committee will be governed by the Council's Standing Orders and the Local Government Code of Conduct for Councillors.

5.0 Sub-Committees and Working Groups

The Committee has the facility, if it so wishes, to establish and appoint any number of Sub-Committees and Working Groups it deems necessary to consider in more detail the work of the Committee concerning specific issues related to the Leisure & Development Directorate. The following Working Groups are proposed for the 2026/27 year:
