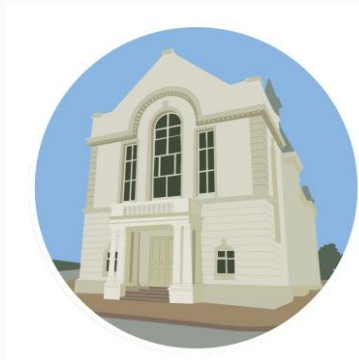

Ballycastle Museum Restoration Project Awarded Funding



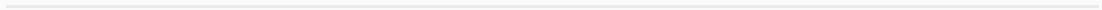
