Re: LA01/2023/1085/F

May I request that the members of the committee that attend the site visit take particular note of the following:

When comparing the photomontages supplied by the applicant of the critical views, that show the production building (now demolished). The proposed lodges sit higher than the previous ridge height / on the skyline. This building was prominent in the landscape prior to its demolition

The row of Sycamore (deciduous) trees that the applicant is relying on for screening from the Craigahulliar Road and Corbally Road public viewpoints

The retaining wall, currently being constructed to retain the proposed cesspool and the distances from this to the proposed lodges, both above and below this wall

The route of the proposed access, at one point within @2m of my boundary and adjacent to where my livestock graze

The location of the collapsed mine at the edge of the adjacent field / beside & under the proposed access

The location of the wall stands in the adjacent agricultural field

As I will be referring to these in my presentation to the committee
