Proposal: - Proposed site for dwelling on a farm

Comments: The site visit commenced at the application site along Drones Rd. The Planning Official identified the site and clarified that nature of the application was for a dwelling on a farm. The official outlined that the proposed development did not satisfy the requirements of CTY 10 as the farm dwelling was not sited adjacent to existing buildings and that it is was well established that a cattle crush does not constitute a building.

The official highlighted the social benefits of siting a farm dwelling with existing building on the farm, as it allows for family support throughout the stages of life and reduces rural isolation. Identified the applicant's farm buildings on submitted farm maps which are located 5km from the site and clarified that Dfl Roads have confirmed the access is accepted subject to modification.

The site visit was concluded.
