PLEASE NOTE

- 1. A licence is issued to an applicant. In the case of a business please provide details of the person who will be holding the licence.
- 2. Any person who in connection with an application for the grant, renewal or variation of a street trading licence makes a statement which he knows to be false shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- 3. If an offer is made and not accepted/validated* within 7 days from the date of offer it will be assumed that you do not wish to obtain a licence and the pitch will be offered to another trader. *An application is only deemed valid if payment, passport sized applicant ID photograph and photograph of stall/receptacle from which trading will take place (including vehicle registration mark where applicable) have been received to facilitate the processing of it.
- 4. If a temporary street trading licence is issued the holder should note that the size of the area provided to trade must not be exceeded. Stalls (including gazebos) are not to encroach onto other pitches, roads or open areas.
- 5. The supply of BB Guns, crossbows or goldfish, either by offering for sale or as a prize, is prohibited.
- 6. Compliance monitoring on the days of the Fair will be ongoing to ensure the conditions of respective licenses are being adhered to. Witnessed offences could result in formal action being taken under the above legislation and the licence may not be renewed for the following year's Lammas Fair.
- 7. Council recommends that all licensed street traders hold current public liability insurance cover for the protection of themselves and the public.
