#### 1.0 Background

The 'Protocol for the Operation of the Planning Committee' sets out the requirement to provide monthly updates on the number of planning applications received and decided.

#### 2.0 Details

- 2.1 Annex 1 and 2 provide a list of planning applications received and decided respectively by Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council in the month of November. Please note these exclude Pre-Application Discussions; Certificates of Lawful development Proposed or Existing); Discharge of Conditions and Non-Material Changes to correspond with official validated statistics published by DoE.
- **2.2** Table 1 below details the number of planning applications received and decided as well as the number of live planning applications in the system and the number of those live applications in the system over 12months.

- 2.3 As is evident from Table 1, the number of applications received in November has continued to remain high, although slightly lower than the previous month. However, it is important to note that there were also 3 Certificate of Lawful Use Proposed/Existing (CLUDs); 7 Pre-Application Discussions (PADs); 5 Discharge of Conditions (DC); and, 1 Non-Material Change (NMC) received in the month of November.
- **2.1** Although the number of applications in the system decreased in the month of November from that in October, the number of decisions issued in November also dropped resulting in an increase in the number of live planning applications in the system.
- **2.2** Table 2 below details the number referral requests received from elected members under Part B of the Scheme of Delegation. The one application determined by the Planning Committee overturned the planning officer recommendation resolving to approve the application. Three of the referred applications are to be determined by the Planning Committee on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2015 with the date for the further 4 referrals yet to be confirmed.
