The purpose of this report is to provide the Committee with an update about grant awards made in the legacy Limavady Borough through the Community Premises Support Programme, funded by Social Investment Fund (SIF).

Background

The Community Premises Support Programme is a project from the legacy Limavady Borough Council which was awarded funding through the Western SIF Zone, made up of the legacy Council areas of Limavady, Fermanagh, Omagh and Strabane.

The aim of the Community Premises Support Programme is to provide financial assistance to help with the renovation and upgrading of community owned facilities in these areas.

Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council and Derry City and Strabane District Council entered into a Partnership Agreement with Fermanagh and Omagh District Council (FODC), who as lead partner, are responsible for the development, management and administration of the project.

Expressions of Interest were invited to the programme in February 2017 which were then scored and ranked by a panel of officers, including officers from the partner councils. The second stage of the Assessment process involved the top scoring/ranked projects receiving an initial premises inspection from a Lead Consultant, appointed by FODC, working under the guidance of the Central Procurement Directorate (CPD).

Feasibility reports were prepared for all 31 selected projects, 8 of which are in the Limavady area and all were deemed feasible and viable by the Lead Consultants. FODC as lead partner has approved the awards and letters of offer have been issued to successful applicants. The successful groups/organisations will not receive any monies directly. FODC, as lead partner, is responsible for all Procurement under the Programme and works will be delivered directly by contractors appointed by the Council.

The list of approved projects in the Limavady area is attached at **Table 1**.
