1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to update members on numbers of Fixed Penalty Notices served by the Environmental Health Department in relation to detected offences of illegal deposition of waste (fly tipping), litter and dog fouling

2.0 Background

- 2.1 In May 2024, Council adopted powers under The Waste and Contaminated Land (Amendment) (2011 Act) (Commencement No.3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022) to enforce two fly-tipping offences under Articles 4 and 5 the unlawful deposit of waste and the householder's duty of care in relation to the transfer of waste.
- 2.2 Under these provisions, Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) may be issued as a first option and alternative to prosecution. In accordance with the Department's Enforcement Policy failure to pay an FPN will result in legal proceedings being initiated for the original offence.
- 2.3 Council set the fixed penalty amount for Article 4 offences at £400, reduced to £300 for early payment and Article 5 offences at £300 reduced to £200 for early payment.
- 2.4 Since Council adopted these powers in May 2024 the following Fixed Penalty Notices have been served:
 - Article 4 offence of depositing waste 12 FPNs
 - Article 5 offence of failure to comply with householders duty of care 8 FPNs
- 2.5 One prosecution for non-payment of a Fixed Penalty Notice relating to the illegal deposit of waste was successfully concluded, with the Court imposing a £300 fine and awarding £90 in costs.
- 2.6 Table below details FPNs for dog fouling and littering offences:

2.7 To keep Members more regularly informed, fixed penalty data will be reported on a quarterly basis.

3.0 Recommendation
