1.0 STREET TRADING LICENCE

1.1 GRANT OF STATIONARY STREET TRADING LICENCE

Licence No: SST 022

Application: Grant of a stationary street trading licence.
Days and times on which it is applied to trade:
Monday to Saturday: 09:00hrs to 17:00hrs.

Goods to be sold: Garden ornaments, household goods, coal, compost, blocks and kindling.

Location: South side of Catherine Street, Limavady between No. 28 and No. 38 Catherine Street. This is a street with designated street trading pitches.

History: There are already traders licensed to trade at this location on a Wednesday and Friday respectively.

Recommendation

It is recommended to grant a stationary street trading licence subject to compliance with any recommendations of the Council's Licensing Department

Due to the general increase in parked vehicles and vehicular traffic in the area it is recommended to restrict trading days to Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday: 09:00hrs to 17:00hrs, to allow all traders to be accommodated.
