1.0 Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this report is to update Elected Members on the outcome of the performance improvement objectives consultation before the information is published within the annual Performance Improvement Plan.

2.0 Background

- 2.1 Under the Local Government Act (NI) 2014, Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council (The Council), is required to publish its annual performance improvement objectives by the end of June each year. The legislation sets out a clear linkage between the performance improvement objectives and the Community Plan.
- 2.2 To align with the legislation, the Council`s 2017/2018 Performance Improvement Plan is based on the objectives that emanated from the work undertaken in relation to the Community Plan. These objectives developed from widespread input with the community planning partners, thematic working groups and the public through workshops organised in each of the seven District Electoral Areas.
- 2.3 Following the workshops a number of objectives were developed and these were subjected to a 12 week public consultation exercise. On completion of this

- process, the Council published its Community Plan for Causeway Coast and Glens.
- 2.4 In April 2017 the Council agreed the 2017/2018 performance improvement objectives and associated projects. Although these objectives had been subjected to widespread consultation as part of the Community Planning process, a further 6 week consultation was carried out through local press, staff newsletter, social media and the Council web site. No changes have been proposed as a result of this additional consultation.

3.0 Detail

3.1 Table 1 below sets out the performance objectives, associated projects and linkage to the Department for Communities, statutory objectives as agreed by the Council in April 2017.
