7.0 SHOPS (SUNDAY TRADING & C.) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1997 DESIGNATION OF BALLYCASTLE AS A HOLIDAY RESORT

Further to members queries research has indicated that as of 1st June 1999 Moyle District Council agreed that Ballycastle be designated a Holiday resort for the purposes of Article 6 of The Shops (Sunday Trading &c.) (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

As such Large shops (that is those with a floor area greater than 280sq m) located in Ballycastle may notify Council of their intention to open at any time on Sunday on up to 18 Sundays (Other than Easter Sunday) between 1 March and 30 September in any Calendar year.

The Environmental Services Department will maintain a register of large shops in the designated Holiday Resorts of Portrush, Portstewart and Ballycastle availing of this relaxation of the specified opening times.

8.0 STREET TRADING ACT (NI) 2001 PROSECUTION FOR ILLEGAL STREET TRADING

The Environmental Services Department of Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council has successfully taken a prosecution against an individual for illegal street trading. This individual had been illegally street trading in an ice cream van throughout various parts of the Borough including Kilrea, Ballymoney, Coleraine and Ballintoy. The case was heard at Coleraine Magistrates Court on Friday 6th October 2017. The defendant did not appear in court but was fined £250, ordered to pay £50 Legal costs, £56 Court costs and a £15 Offender Levy imposed.
