## 1.0 BACKGROUND

The purpose of this report is to consider and agree Council representation at the annual Remembrance Sunday services across the Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council area (see attached table).

## 1.1 COUNCIL REPRESENTATION

At its meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2015 Council agreed that attendance at Remembrance Services across the Borough would be that:

"The Mayor and Deputy Mayor decide which event they wish to attend on Remembrance Sunday and that the other Elected Members be nominated to represent Council by Party Leads using d'Hondt."

This process was followed and other Members attended services in the area of their choice.

The Chief Executive nominated a Senior Officer to attend each of the services with the nominated Elected Member.

## 2.0 RECOMMENDATION

As per the decision at the Council Meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2015, it is recommended that the Mayor and Deputy Mayor decide which event they wish to attend on Remembrance Sunday and that the other Elected Members be nominated by Party Leads using d'Hondt.
