## 1.1 Background

Legacy Limavady Borough Council has a lease agreement with Lough Foyle Ferry Company to provide a pier, slipway and ferry terminal to deliver a ferry service between Magilligan and Green Castle. This agreement commenced on the 21<sup>st</sup> October 2014 and terminates 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016 with an option to extend the Term on 2 occasions for a period of 2 years on each occasion.

#### 1.2 Notice

The Foyle Ferry Company has given notice not to extend the contract and will no longer be providing the ferry service as of 30 March 2016.

Consultation with officers from Donegal County Council has already initiated and options for the future of the ferry service will be explored and brought back to the Environmental Services Committee for decision in early 2016.
