This purpose of this report is to consider Council financial contribution and membership of Twinning Associations.

1.0 **Background**:

The Council decided in March 2016 (CPR15/3/16 – Appendix 1) to transfer legacy Council twinning arrangements and contributions into the 2016/17 financial year to facilitate a review of the twinning associations and a recommendation to Corporate Policy and Resources prior to the 2017/18 estimates process.

Presentations were received from Moyle, Coleraine and Limavady Twinning Associations at a Workshop on 30th November 2016. Ballymoney provided a written submission attached at Appendix 2. Each Twinning Association outlined their aims, objectives and plans for 2017.

1.0 Background

1.1 Each of the four Legacy Councils had a Twinning relationship with other towns, aimed at promoting friendship and understanding. The relationships were managed through Twinning Associations. The Legacy Councils offered varying degrees of Financial, Officer and Elected Member support as detailed in the table below:

2.0 Twinning post 2015

- 2.1 The Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council (the Council) agreed that the Twinning arrangements relating to the Legacy Councils should be rolled over to the new Council for 2015/2016.
- 2.2 The Twinning relationships have been developed over many years. The convergence of the four Legacy Councils has created a degree of uncertainty with the various Twinning Associations as to the future commitment of the Council. At this stage each of the Associations is in the process of planning activities for 2016/2017 and will require clarification on Council funding.
- 2.3 As part of the 2016/2017 estimates process, the funding allocation for the four Legacy Council Twinning Associations has been carried over. Subject to Council approval this funding is available.
- 2.4 Currently, Council Officers have been tasked with compiling information in relation to the various projects undertaken by the Twinning Associations. This information will assist in assessing the longer term approach for Council.
- 2.5 In terms of the 2016/2017 financial year, funding has been allowed for as part of the budget process and this will enable the Twinning Associations to plan their in year projects. A report on the longer term approach will be presented to the Corporate Policy and Resources Committee prior to the 2017/2018 estimates process.

3.0 Recommendation

It is recommended that the Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council approve the transfer of the Legacy Council Twinning arrangements into the 2016/2017 financial year.
