	While National Insurance contributions are an excepted matter under Schedule 2 to the Northern Ireland Act 1998 and the responsibility of HMRC, the proposals will require consequential changes to Northern Ireland Social Security legislation. The Department for Social Development has, therefore, made the consultation document available in Northern Ireland to ensure that people here have the opportunity to express their views. The deadline for response is Wednesday 24 February 2016.  The self-employed currently pay two rates of National Insurance contributions:  Class 2 – Prior to 2015/16, Class 2 National Insurance contributions were paid at a flat weekly rate for each week of self-employment (£2.75 in 2014/15). From 2015/16, to simplify the collection process, they were brought within the self assessment framework, with the amount due being calculated on an annual basis. Class 2 National Insurance contributions provide the self-employed with access to the State Pension, contribution-based Employment and Support Allowance, Maternity Allowance and Bereavement Benefits.				
	• Class 4 – These are a percentage charge on profit. The contributor pays 9 per cent on annual profits between the lower profits limit (£8,060 in 2015/16) and the upper profits limit (£42,385 in 2015/16), and 2 per cent on any profit over that amount. Class 4 National Insurance contributions have no link to benefit entitlement.				
	The proposed changes mean that, in the future, instead of paying two classes of National Insurance contribution, the self-employed will pay just one, Class 4.				
	The consultation explores how a reformed system of National Insurance contributions for the self-employed could confer benefit entitlement and the policy choices that will be considered in designing the new contributory benefit tests.
