### 1.0 Background

1.1 The Department of Enterprise, Trade & Investment has written to Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council to advise that it has received 2 applications from Dalradian Gold Ltd for mineral prospecting rights under section 11 of the Mineral Development Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 in respect of an area in Counties Londonderry and Tyrone.

# 2.0 Detail

- 2.1 The proposed area for mineral prospecting covers a total area of 152.1sqmiles within the Council areas of Causeway Coast and Glens, Derry City and Strabane, and Mid Ulster.
- 2.2 The attached maps indicate the extent to which the proposed prospecting falls within Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council stretching from Feeny to north of Foreglen and across to west of Evishagaran in the north and Glenshane Forest in the south and southwards to the council boundary area with Mid Ulster.

- 2.3 Before coming to a decision on the matter, in accordance with subsections 11(4) and 11(5) of the Act, DETI is required to serve notice on Council of its intention to grant the licence and to take into account any representations which are made to it within one month from the date of receipt of its letter.
- 2.4 The consultation exercise will close on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2016.



In 2012 we released an independent, positive Preliminary Economic Assessment of the Curraghinalt deposit based upon the November 2011 mineral resource estimate.

Early in 2013 we submitted an application for planning permission that will allow us to carry out an underground exploration development program, including the extraction of a bulk sample. While we await receipt of that permission we are working on a new resource estimate at Curraghinalt and testing the exploration potential of elsewhere on our 84,000 hectare property.

In summary, our PEA on our most recent 43-101 compliant resource estimate shows that we have a high grade, high margin deposit with relatively low capital expenditures required to build a 145,000 ounce per year mine. The operation is located in a low risk jurisdiction.






