## APPLICATION NO LOCATION PROPOSAL LA01/2024/1221/F The application site is Proposed Dunbeg South Extension Wind Farm comlocated on lands to the prising 4no, three bladed wind turbines, each up to north of A37, to the west 149.9m maximum tip height; associated electricity of the existing Dunbeg transformers; underground cabling; access tracks; Wind Farm and lands to turning heads; site entrances; crane hardstandings; the south of A37 adjacent control building and substation compound and to a disused quarry, in the off-site areas of widening to the public road and all ancillary works. During construction and comtownlands of Dunbeg and missioning there would be a number of temporary Dunmore, 6.2km north east of Limavady works including a construction compound with car parking: temporary parts of crane hardstandings and welfare facilities.
