



CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN DESIGNATED PLACES

Bye-Laws made by Limavady Borough Council under Section 90 (a) of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1972 for the good rule and government of its district at a meeting of the Council held on 21 August 2007.

Interpretation

1. – In these bye-laws –

“**The Council**” means Limavady Borough Council.

“**Designated Place**” means any place specified in the Schedule excepting:

- (a) any area which is within the curtilage of any licensed premises or registered club; or
- (b) any place at which the sale of intoxicating liquor is authorised by virtue of an occasional licence.

“**Intoxicating Liquor**” has the same meaning as in the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996;

“**Licensed Premises**” and “**Occasional Licence**” have the same meanings as in the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996;

“**Registered Club**” means a club registered under the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996.

Extent

- 2. (i) These bye-laws apply to all designated places.
- (ii) Notice of the effect of these bye-laws shall be given by signs placed in such positions as the Council may consider adequate to inform persons using designated places.


Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor in Designated Places

3. Any person who consumes intoxicating liquor in a designated place, shall be guilty of an offence.


Revocation

4. From and after the date on which these bye-laws shall come into operation, the bye-laws relating to the consumption of intoxicating liquor in designated places made by the Council on 25th October 2000 and confirmed by the Department of Social Development for Northern Ireland on 1st February 2001 shall be and are hereby revoked.

CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN DESIGNATED PLACES

Bye-laws made by Coleraine Borough Council under Section 90(a) of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1972 for the good rule and government of its district at a meeting of the Council held on the 28 of September 2010.

INTERPRETATION

1. In these bye-laws:

“The Council” means Coleraine Borough Council.

“Designated place” means any place specified in the schedule, excepting:-

- (a) any area which is within the curtilage of any licensed premises or registered club; or
- (b) any place at which the sale of intoxicating liquor is authorised by virtue of an occasional licence.

“Intoxicating liquor” has the same meaning as in the Licensing (NI) Order 1996.

“Licensed premises” and “occasional licence” have the same meaning as in the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996.

“Registered club” means a club registered under the Registration of clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996.

EXTENT

2. (1) These bye-laws apply to all designated places.
- (2) Notice of the effect of these bye-laws shall be given by signs placed in such positions as the Council may consider adequate to inform persons using designated places.

CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN DESIGNATED PLACES

3. Any person who consumes intoxicating liquor in a designated place shall be guilty of an offence.

REVOCATION

4. Bye-laws relating to the consumption of intoxicating liquor in designated places made by the Council on 27 May 2003 and confirmed by the Department for Social Development for Northern Ireland on 24 September 2003 shall be and are hereby revoked therefrom.
